**Divine Mercy Sunday** Today the Church throughout the world celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday.

From the Diary of St. Faustina it is clear that this Octave Day of Easter is a day chosen by Christ as a day of extraordinary graces—a complete outpouring of His mercy upon all who approach Him with great trust & faith. St. John Paul II canonized Sr. Faustina on Divine Mercy Sunday in 2000 and established Divine Mercy Sunday as a feast day for the entire Church.

Two requirements: Reconciliation during Lent and receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday. If you do this you will obtain complete forgiveness of sin and its punishment (Plenary Indulgence)
