From: Bishop W. Shawn McKnight Re: The Catholic Missourian Subscriptions

Recognizing the important role our diocesan newspaper, The Catholic Missourian, serves in our local Church, all parishioners will receive the publication beginning with the first issue after July 1, 2019. The only exception will be for those who explicitly do not wish to receive it.

While we are growing our digital outreach, The Catholic Missourian has been our primary tool for evangelization since the Diocese was founded. Sometimes it is the only Catholic print publication in a household and it is critical our people have a Catholic perspective on contemporary issues. It is an effective extension of the teaching role of the Bishop.

I know some parishes have reduced subscriptions because of limited financial resources. Considering that concern, there will no longer be a separate assessment for The Catholic Missourian. Instead, as with other services of the Diocese, the cost of the paper will be added to the cathedraticum. As one local Church, parishes of more substantial means will help provide the paper to members of parishes with financial concerns. Parishes will no longer receive a separate assessment for The Catholic Missourian, but will continue The Catholic Missourian envelope in your packets to help offset the cost. Proceeds from this will go toward payment of the cathedraticum. (*parish tax*)

I commend the staff of The Catholic Missourian for publishing a professional and relevant diocesan paper. In the communication audit conducted last year, the newspaper received good marks. However, some respondents recommended it needed to become more accessible to younger Catholics, both in content and delivery methods.

High quality communication efforts allow our Diocese to be better, together. The Catholic Missourian, along with our digital channels, brings Catholics together in our large Diocese, helping all of us become a closer community of faith. To assist us in having the best possible communication tools, I will be appointing a communications advisory committee which will provide ongoing recommendations for all of our communication work, including The Catholic Missourian.
